FUNDING:

The NPQs are fully funded for state funded organisations.

Targeted Support Funding for 2023 - 2024:

State-funded primary schools with 1 to 150 pupils will receive a grant of £800 per applicant.

State-funded primary schools with more than 150 pupils and state-funded secondary schools with 1 to 600 pupils will receive a grant of £200 per applicant.

NPQEYL funding:

It is fully funded for people employed by a:

- maintained nursery school in England
- pre-school class or nursery that's part of a maintained school or an independent school in England providing free early years' entitlements places
- nursey, pre-school or childminder registered on the Ofsted Early Years Register, or with a registered childminder agency

Targeted Support Funding: Additional grants of £200-600 are available subject to the above DfE eligibility criteria.


